ORDINANCE NO. 383

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE III, SECTION 2-83 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TO PERMIT DISCRETION WITH REGARDS TO THE RESIDENCE OF THE TOWN MANAGER.

WHEREAS, Article VI, Section 4.01 of the Town Charter provides that the qualifications of the Town Manager, "shall be prescribed by ordinance; "and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 235, Section 1 (08-28-90), codified at Chapter 2, Article III, Section 2-83 of the Code of Ordinance, provides that the Town Manager "shall reside within the town limits;" and

WHEREAS, the Town finds that it is in the best interest of the Town to permit discretion with regard to the matter of the residence of the Town Manager.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF HAVANA, FLORIDA THAT:

Chapter 2, Article III, Section of the Code of Ordinance is amended as follows:

Section 2-83. Residence.

The Town Council may require the Town Manager to reside within the Town limits, or within such other geographic area as it determines appropriate and in the best interest of the Town, and may provide time-limits for compliance with any such requirement.
